ICR Dress Guidelines

This is a reminder that all who attend our Sunday school will dress in accordance with Islamic guidelines based on the Quran and Sunnah. Being respectful to the mosque and its premises is essential for all who enter the mosque and the following guidelines outline our standards for our center's etiquette.

General Guidelines (applies to all students and teachers):

- All are required to wear clean and neat clothing which must cover the body loosely without being transparent, revealing, or tight.
- Outfits cannot reveal bare waist line, abdomen or deep neckline.
- Any clothing material should not <u>display</u> inappropriate images or language.
- Caps (sport) or sunglasses are not allowed in the classrooms.

Male Dress Guidelines

- Males are required to wear clean shirts and long pants that are loose fitting.
- Although pants are preferred, shorts can be worn if they fall below the knees.

Female Dress Guidelines

- Females are required to be in hijab covering all body parts except the face and hands.
 - Girl's clothes should not expose the legs girls cannot wear shorts and short dresses.
 - Tops should have long sleeves tank tops or deep necklines are not allowed.
- Girls should wear a head cover.
 - Girls 9 years of age and over are required to keep their head covered during school.
 - Girls younger than 9 should wear head covering during Quranic class and Salah.

The purpose of the school is to strengthen our children's Muslim identity by providing them an environment that is not conflicting with Islamic values. Parents' cooperation in this matter is vital to the success of the school and we encourage parents to be role models for their children. Teachers should also present themselves as role models to the students by maintaining proper attire as outlined above.
